Search For Seven

Is your group looking for an accessible way for every member to engage with the scriptures both individually and collectively? And you want to do it without having to use any kind of book or video study? Then we have a great option for you!

Search For Seven is a simple framework to use for personal study and group discussions. Every time you open your bible (no matter where you turn) you ask seven questions as a way to engage your heart and mind with the text. These seven questions then serve as great conversation starters for any group.

Follow these simple steps:

- Choose a book of the Bible (we'd recommend starting with a book in New Testament).
- Decide how much you want to study each week (chapter-by-chapter, section-by-section, etc.).
- Everyone reads the weekly selection throughout the week, using the questions in their study time.
- Come together and use the seven questions as the foundation of your collective conversation.

The Seven questions:

- What is the main idea of this passage?
- What is the key verse in this passage?
- Are there any parallel scriptures or references that enhance the meaning of this passage?
- What questions would a skeptic ask about this passage?
- What things are difficult for you to understand?
- What practical application do you find in this passage?
- What promises of God do you find in this passage?
